#### 1. Call to Order & Introductions

The Middle Santa Ana River Watershed Pathogen (MSAR) TMDL Task Force meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Mark Norton at Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA). Brief introductions were made by the attendees.

### 2. Approval of the Meeting Notes

Mark Norton asked for any comments on the April 26, 2016 meeting notes. There were no comments and the meeting notes were deemed acceptable.

### 3. Update: Regional Monitoring Program (CDM Smith)

Richard Meyerhoff /CDM Smith provided an update on the second quarter of the dry weather monitoring program. He indicated the report is now complete. He reported that some results were delayed from the Orange County laboratory due to a fire they had, but they are now running geomeans and work that had been delayed is now being resolved.

# 4. Update: Uncontrollable Sources Investigation (CDM Smith & RCFC&WCD)

Richard Meyerhoff stated the report on the uncontrollable sources investigation is now complete and has been submitted to the Regional Board. It was also reported that under the Riverside County E.coli monitoring, the antidegradation targets were being exceeded at one location near Temescal Creek. So in accordance with regulations, monitoring will be conducted at this site on a monthly basis for the next three months until the pathogen source is identified. The database for this data is now being entered into CEDEN.

# 5. Update: Comprehensive Bacteria Reduction Plan Implementation Activities

## RCFC&WCD

Eric Lomeli reported that work is continuing on the Eastvale mitigation at Lines D & E channels that drain to the Santa Ana River. CDM is involved in the scoping.

### SBCFCD

Marc Rodabaugh said that OCWD is assisting by taking samples in Chino Creek and the San Antonio Channel. This is a 10-week study near IEUA's RP4 plant to verify the mass balance. His staff is also working to modify Chris Basin to improve dry weather flow capture. His district also is working on the preparation of a stromwater resource plan to pursue a \$500,000 grant under the Prop 1 SWRCB stormwater grant program.

### Orange County

Suzan Given reported that the annual report for the Newport Bays will be done in September 2016.

# Pomona & Claremont

Julie Carver reported that a BMP summary report will be posted soon. The city is waiting on further action regarding compliance until lawsuits are resolved regarding their stormwater permit.

# **Agricultural Operators**

Pat Boldt said there is nothing new to report at this time.

## **Budget Update**

Mark Norton stated that he had nothing new to report about the budget.

## FY 2016-17 Invoice

Mark Norton said that invoices for FY 2016-17 have now been sent out to most of the task force agencies.

#### **Other Business**

Tim Moore requested copies of all pathogen sampling reports from Riverside County and San Bernardino County. He indicated that he would like to do an analysis of the geomean of both sampling sites for Reach 3 to ensure legal compliance for both counties. CDM will be addressing this issue as well in their next annual monitoring report.
